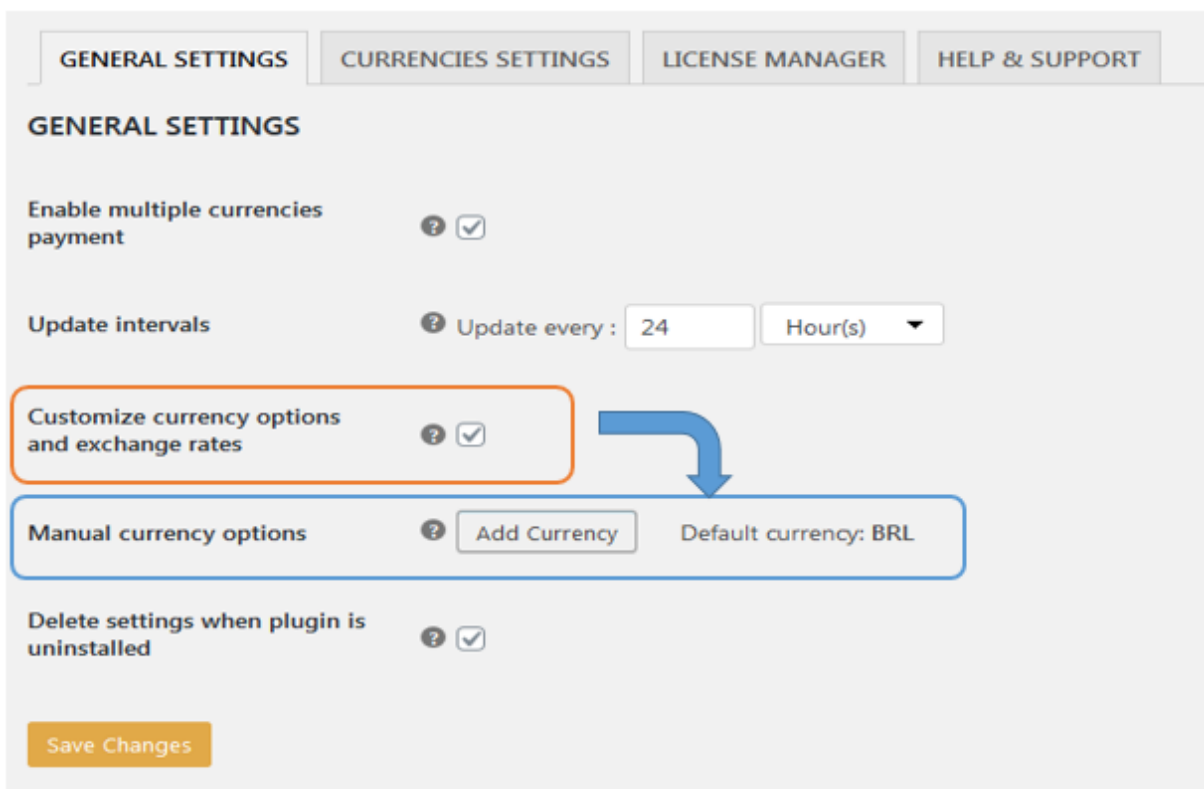


SCD - CUSTOMIZE CURRENCY FORMAT AND EXCHANGE RATE

SCD allows you to manually specify **the exchange rate** to use between the default currency of your store and another currency, the additional percentage to apply in addition to the exchange rate or **to customize the currency symbol** to display for a currency as well as the choice of its format and position.

On the WordPress admin dashboard go to *Woocommerce > SCD currencies > General settings* and then enable *Customize currency options and exchange rates*, as illustrated bellow.



When customize currency options and exchange rates is enabled: You can use the Manual Currency Options setting to specify custom options for the currencies of your choice.

Manual currency options allow you to add each currency for which you want to manually specify the exchange rate, a percentage based price increase, or the display format. For currencies not included in the table, the normal exchange rate and default display format will be used. The bellow picture shows you an example.

Customize currency options and exchange rates



Add a new currency to the list

For each currency, you can specify: the exchange rate to apply, a percentage increase to add on top of the exchange rate, a custom currency symbol to display and the symbol position. You can leave the Rate or Symbol box empty to use the normal exchange rate or the default currency symbol.

Manual currency options



Add Currency

Default currency: XAF

This is the list of currencies for which the user has defined a custom exchange rate or display options. For currencies not included in this list the normal exchange rate and default display options are used.

After doing this setup, save the change and go to the store to have a preview. The below picture illustrates an example.
